Kelly was quickly convinced that the vast majority of the faithful the world over, commoners like himself, just might reconsider their religious roots and motivations in a new light if they actually bothered to immerse themselves for a time in their own sacred scriptures, rather than merely fake familiarity with them. Actually to read scripture in all its antiquated, tendentious, sectarian absurdity, Kelly reasoned, is to take a first, giant step in renouncing irrational creeds of all kinds. open-minded reader will draw a secularly pure, spiritual sustenance.
