4. MAN VS. SOCIETY

THIS CONFLICT ARISES WHEN A CHARACTER OPPOSES SOCIETAL NORMS, LAWS, OR CULTURAL EXPECTATIONS. IT'S COMMON IN STORIES THAT ADDRESS SOCIAL JUSTICE, REBELLION, OR CONFORMITY.

5. MAN VS. TECHNOLOGY
