However, six months before he died, he laid the foundation for, and founded with Sylvia, a shelter for homeless women and children, which Sylvia is still operating, over 21 years later, as Sylvia's Haven. As the shelter has grown and changed over the years, the joys, sorrows, and hardships are carefully documented. It closes as Sylvia is taking on still other challenges, relying totally on God's direction, protection and love for everyone who has ever donated to, volunteered for, worked at or resided at Sylvia's Haven.
