**Would water, given enough heat, instantly vaporize?** This means that if pressure changes substantially during the boiling process, the heat of vaporization of the water will also change substantially during the boiling process. To

**thermodynamics - Temperature of steam rising off boiling water** The 'boiling point' of water is the temperature at which steam and liquid exist at equilibrium, and the roiling boil of a pot of water on the stove indicates a lack of equilibrium

**What is the real cause of the boiling (forming of bubbles) of water?** No, I was looking for the actual cause of the boiling of water. Is it the temperature or the vapor pressure that equals the external pressure? Or are they both causes?

**Why is water inside a vacuum chamber not boiling?** So when you put a glass of water into a vacuum chamber at room temperature and lower the pressure, what will happen? The water will indeed boil briefly - but boiling means that
