interpretation problems. Assessment of the responses of the stakeholders is accepted as a tool for developing a better interpretation of the cultural heritage buildings, preventing them from further neglect or possible extinction. This research proposes the advancement of interpretive approaches for similar undervalued and underappreciated sites. There are many abandoned heritage buildings worldwide and due to the lack of function and maintenance, deteriorate easily and are ruined. Similarly, abandoned valuable religious buildings have faced vandalism deliberately because of the decreasing demand for use or lack of their communities, and many of them have been insufficiently interpreted for their visitors. This research aims to develop an interpretive plan for the churches in the Walled City of Famagusta to overcome their current problems.
