DISCOVERING PURPOSE: WHAT I LIVED FOR

ALIGNING ACTIONS WITH VALUES

LIVING WITH PURPOSE MEANS ALIGNING OUR BEHAVIORS AND CHOICES WITH OUR CORE BELIEFS. THIS ALIGNMENT FOSTERS AUTHENTICITY AND SATISFACTION, REDUCING THE DISCONNECT BETWEEN WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO. IT ENCOURAGES INTENTIONAL LIVING RATHER THAN DRIFTING THROUGH LIFE WITHOUT DIRECTION.

LESSONS FROM THOREAU'S "FROM WHERE I LIVED AND WHAT I LIVED FOR"

- **SEEK COMMUNITY:** SURROUND YOURSELF WITH PEOPLE WHO SHARE OR SUPPORT YOUR VALUES AND ASPIRATIONS.

WHY REFLECTING ON WHERE AND WHY MATTERS

2. **CONS:** LIMITED APPLICABILITY FOR THOSE WITHOUT FINANCIAL OR SOCIAL FLEXIBILITY; POTENTIAL FOR IDEALIZING SOLITUDE.
